Swan Lake Commemorative Bricks

Be a permanent part of the future of Hershey Gardens by purchasing a personalized paver to be installed around historic Swan Lake, just across from the Milton & Catherine Hershey Conservatory.

Swan Lake, initially called the Reflecting Pool, was part of the original Hershey Rose Garden Milton Hershey created in 1937. Harry Erdman, who designed the original garden, always favored the pond, calling it “the magnificent erosion gully that resulted from the construction of the hotel. . .it made a wonderful pond for irrigation and ornamentation.”

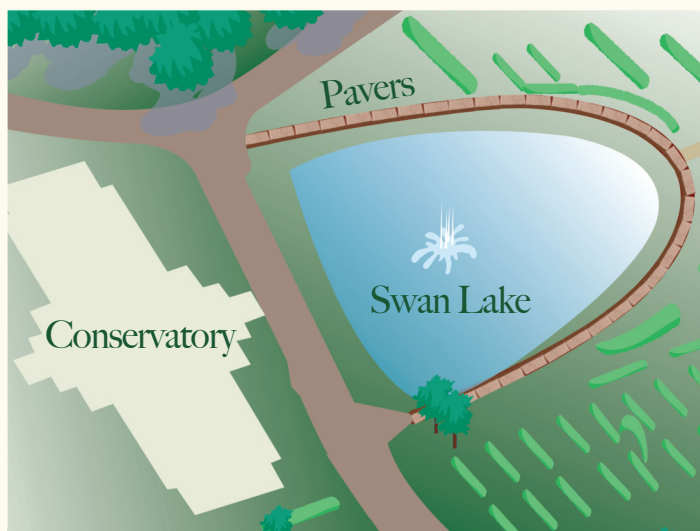
In the mid-1950s, Hershey Gardens introduced swans in the pond, leading to its current name, “Swan Lake.”

The personalized pavers are an enduring tribute to loved ones or friends, and a unique way to celebrate holidays, graduations, birthdays or other special occasions.

The newly expanded path around Swan Lake will be created using 9,000 pavers. The premium 4” x 8” pavers will take center stage as they line the main walkway around the lake.
